## INFORMATION CLAUSE REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

In compliance with the requirements provided for in Article 13 par. 1 and 2 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR).

We hereby inform that:

1. The administrator of your personal data is the Polish Society of Andrology hereinafter referred to as the Administrator.
2. The Administrator conducts the operation of processing your personal data such as:

- name,
  - home address contact details (address, telephone number, e-mail),
  - work address contact details (address, telephone number, e-mail),
  - education, academic title/ academic degree, specialty,
  - image and biographical note
3. Your personal data will be processed in order to execute the statutory tasks of the Administrator.
  4. The basis for processing your personal data is the Statement for publishing on *Advances in Adrology Online*.
  5. Providing the data is voluntary but necessary for executing the tasks included in the documents listed in point 3; in the case of not providing the data it is impossible to fulfil the aforesated purpose.
  6. You have the right to:
    - demand from the Administrator access to yor personal data and receive their copies (art. 15 of GDPR)
    - correct them if they are faulty (art. 16 of GDPR)
    - remove them, i.e. ‘right to be forgotten’ (art. 17 of GDPR). This right does not apply, however, in the scope in which the processing is necessary, among other things to comply with the legal responsibilities of the Administrator or to identify, seek and defend claims.
    - limit the processing of personal data (art. 18 of GDPR),
    - object to the processing of data obtained on the basis of a granted consent (art. 21 of GDPR),
    - transfer data (art. 20 of GDPR)
    - file a complaint to the supervisory body i.e. the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if you believe that the processing of data violates the regulations of the law (art. 13 par. 2 point D of GDPR)
    - withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data (art. 13 par. 2 point C of GDPR). At any time you are entitled to withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data which we process on the basis of the consent. Withdrawing the consent will not affect the legality of the processing which was made on the basis of the granted consent before it was withdrawn.
  7. Your personal data are not subject to automatized decision making, including profiling.
  8. Your personal data will be stored for the duration of the procedures related to the publication of the article in the *Advances in Andrology Online*.
